

FEED DISTRIBUTION IN PRACTICE

Take the natural behaviour of the hen into account

EMPTY FEEDERS DAILY



Make sure all the fine particles are eaten: **Selective eating** ---

Enhance crop and gizzard development:

Feed storage capacity +++

CALCIUM APETITE EFFECT



Increase feed and calcium intake in the last hours of the day:
Shell quality +++

IN PRACTICE:

- → Emptying the feeders should progressively be applied in rearing as from 4 weeks of age
- → Main feed distribution in the afternoon
- → Adjust the quantity of feed distributed in the morning to obtain an empty feeder in the middle of the day
- → Use a minimum number of feed distributions to avoid risk of competition between the birds
